



## Storyboard:

A storyboard is probably the most useful planning document for both inexperienced and professional video makers. It consists of frame-by-frame sketches that indicate the content of each scene and the way in which it will be shot—that is, shot type, angles, and so on. Accompanying notes can be used to describe what you are trying to achieve in each shot as well as audio notes. You do not have to be a great artist to produce a useful storyboard since it is generally only for your own reference. The advantage of this kind of document is that it helps you to visualize not only individual scenes but also the overall pace of the action and atmosphere of your planned video.
